She was also granted the AusAid Scholarship that brought her to Australia to finish a Masters’ Degree in Regional Development at University of Queensland in 2004.

She started working in NIA UPRIIS in 1986 as an Engineer A. Eventually, she became Division Manager in 2009 to 2011 and Acting Operations Manager until 2012. Through her excellence, leadership and hard work, she was promoted as Department Manager in September 4, 2012.

For two consecutive years (2010-2011), her division was the recipient of the “Best Division Award”.
