



Laur Communal Irrigators Association Success Story

Laur Communal Irrigators Association Inc. formerly Pinagbaryuhan Irrigators Association Inc. by 1974 the NIA castoff its pilot project for communal irrigation system which was constructed at Brgy. 3 of Laur province of Nueva Ecija. NIA constructed brass Dam to irrigate 100 hectare of land field for palay planting with 30 farmers beneficiaries. Due to typhoon after 3 years of constructed dam, the facility was damaged and the farmers of Pinagbaryuhan Irrigators Association lose their hope and begun to shift their livelihood aside from palay planting.

Few years later, in 2017, a man named Cesar Bantigue stood up and initiate breakthrough to his fellow farmers to held their dream to plant again. He initiated the renewal of the association into Laur Communal Irrigators Association. He asked help to various government agencies to help them re construct the damaged dam and plant again. He taps the National Irrigation Administration Region 3, BANE IMO and proposed to reconstruct and rehabilitate the damaged dam, canal and their irrigation facility.

NIA did not fail the appeal of Mr. Bantigue for his fellow kababayan to continue their dream of contributing to the countries need for food sufficiency. The canal projects for Laur CIS were approved and constructed by year 2020 and 2022.

Today, the LACIA irrigates 1100 Has with 682 farmers beneficiaries with which was 498 were male and 184 were female. They have 2 cropping seasons in a year. The actual yield per Hectarage was 130 Cavan's of palay.

All machineries from Department of Agriculture used by the Association were one of the sources of their income generating fund and the savings were also used to buy other machineries. The operation and maintenance of the Association were also utilized to support the operation in general of the association.

The subsidy from NIA were also plays a big part on the development of the IA, it supports the canal clearing using the backhoe that finances by the subsidy.

The 5-year development plan of the association were keeping them forward as the operates with discipline and goal driven. The officials set good example through discipline which was the key of the association on running a good and outstanding Irrigators association.

They are from scratch going in to pure gold and ideal association to its neighboring farmers. They became admirable by others through the values and setting their mind that helping each member and sustain their livelihood through the undying help and support of all the government agencies, providing them trainings, seminars, learning and applying it to develop their skills and promote sustainable livelihood through farming and maintaining sufficient irrigation service to its members.
